- CAMPSITE COOKING: TRIBES ARE ON THEIR OWN.
- TRAIL'S END RESTAURANT: <u>All-you-can-eat-buffet</u>, Menu includes: Scrambled eggs, sausage, bacon, hash browns, biscuits & gravy, French Toast, fresh fruit, donuts, fried chicken, fajitas, sandwiches, chili, soup, salad. Take-out pizza, snacks and sweets.
- MICKYEY'S BACKYARD BBQ: <u>All-you-can-eat-buffet</u>, Come join Mickey, Minnie,
 Sarsaprilla Sal, Tom Palen and Tumbleweed, for a hearty country picnic. With a full lineup of line-dancin', western-singin', rope-trickin', kid-friendly entertainment, the roof of

CAMPING INFORMATION:

- DATES: Disney's Fort Wilderness has been reserved by the Teton Nation from Friday,
 March 4th, through Sunday March 6th.
- CHECK IN-OUT: Check in time is 1:00 PM on Friday. Check out time is by 11:00 AM Sunday.
- GROUP CAMP SITE FACILITIES: We are camping in the Creekside Meadow area. The
 area can hold up to 250 people maximum. Creekside Meadow is divided into 6 sites.
 We will divide those sites by tribes once we have a final head count.
- COST: \$50 per person for the weekend. Pop ups are extra. Payments can only be accepted online at <u>www.tetonnation.com</u>.
- CAMPING SPACE: Disney assumes you have roughly a 10 x 11 tent. To fit everyone in,
 please set up your tents relatively close together. This ultimately depends on how
 many people attend.
- TENTS: Bring your own tent and supplies
- AWNINGS: Awnings are allowed, but be aware of camping space. Be creative, but be considerate of other tribes.
- GRILLS: A stationary charcoal grill is available in each of the six campsites. Because there are only six grilss, you may want to bring your own propane grill.
- FOOD: All tribes are on their own.
- PINIC TABLES: Each of the six campsites have picnic tables. Tribes may bring additional tables. There should be 5 tables per site.
- CAMPFIRES: Disney has established only 6 designated spots for fire pits. You can only
 use these pits. NO OPEN FIRES ARE ALLOWED EXCEPT IN THESE PITS.
- FIREWOOD: The Nation will order some firewood and it is included in the cost. Disney does have firewood for purchase. You may also bring your own firewood.
- ELECTRICAL: There are no electrical hook-ups down at the Creekside Meadow campsite. There is power at the Comfort Station.

- RESTROOMS: Nearby facilities include a Comfort Station with AC, private showers, restrooms, house and public phones and laundry.
- EQUIPMENT DROP OFF: In addition to the 12 vehicles allowed in our camping area, all vehicles will be allowed to drive to the site upon arrival to drop off supplies at the site. They then must return to the main parking lot due to the limit of 12 parking spots.
- PARKING & STORAGE TRAILERS: Storge trailers may be parked overnight down at the
 campiste. Specifically, the six camping sites have 2 overnight parking spots each.
 Trailers may be kept there. The rest of us need to park in the main lot, a Disney
 transport coach running down to the campsite every 15-20 minutes. The site is NOT
 withing walking distance from the main parking lot.
- POP-UP CAMPERS: Absolutley NO travel trailers, pop-ups, motor homes or other campers are allowed at Creekside Meadow.
- GOLF CARTS: Disney does rent golf carts at \$59 + tax per 24 hours. However, a golf cart is not really necessary at this site. Golf carts must be parked at the Comfort Station not the camp site. There are a limited number so reserve the now at (407) 939-7807 (Group Reservations).
- ACTIVITIES: All activities are on your own. There will be NO Teton Nation events. Plan ahead with your tribes and your buddies.
- SECURITY ID KEY: Each tribe will be issued a security key allowing after hours access to nearby Ft. Wilderness facilities. The ID Key will also allow vehicles to come and go after hours.

Address: 4510 N. Fort Wilderness Trl, Bay Lake FL (Distance from Coral Springs 201. Miles, time: 3 hours 8 mins.

- Take ramp onto Florida's Turnpike N towards Orlando.
 Go (182 miles)
- Take exit #249/Osceola Parkway, go .3 miles
- Turn left on E Osceola Parkway, go .2 miles
- Continue on CR-522 W (Portions Toll) go 6. Miles
- Take ramp onto N. Poinciana Blvd toward Resort Area (US-192) go .5 miles
- Turn Right on SR-535 N go 1.3 miles
- Bear LEFT on SR-536 W go 1.6 miles
- Continue on Epcot Center Dr, go 1.4 miles
- Take ramp onto Disney Vacation Club Way toward
 Downtown Disney Resort Area, go .3 miles
- Turn LEFT on Bonnet Creek Parkway, to 1.0 miles
- Turn LEFT on Vista Blvd, go .9 miles
- Turn RIGHT on Fort Wilderness Trl (Gate Access Required)
 go 1.3 miles
- Arrive at 4510 N. Fort Wilderness Trl, Bay Lake, on LEFT
